

The regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township Board of Supervisors was called to order on April 5, 2012 at 7 p.m. Present were Bill Goodrich, Ted Plevinsky, Jim Lindsey, G. T. Southworth, Lori Raub, Clifford Reed, Lenny Kalechitz, and Linda Rockwell.

Public Comments None.

Minutes Bill made a motion to accept the March 2012 Meeting Minutes as presented. Jim seconded and Ted voted yes.

Bill made a motion that the request for a donation to the Endless Mts. Visitors Bureau not be made at this time. Ted seconded and Jim voted yes.

Linda reported ongoing computer problems with the computer that has been rebuilt several times and that a new computer might have to be purchased. Lenny Kalechitz noted that he could build a computer for the township and only charge for the parts. Bill made a motion to have Lenny Kalechitz build a computer for the township and submit an invoice. Ted seconded and Jim voted yes.

Information on the 2012 Dirt & Gravel Road Grant Program will be looked over by Bill.
