Bill made a motion to hold the regular monthly meeting of the Liberty Township Board of Supervisors on the first Thursday of each month at the township building at 7 p.m. Alton seconded.

Alton made a motion to appoint Bill Goodrich as the voting delegate for the township at the annual spring convention in Hershey. Bill seconded. Bill made a motion that Alton be authorized to attend the convention. Alton seconded.

Bill made a motion to appoint Susquehanna County Council of Governments Sewage Enforcement person to perform any sewage enforcement work. Alton seconded.

Bill made a motion to appoint Susquehanna County Council of Governments Codes and BIU to do the UCC inspections or others as specified by the committee for all permits and code work. Alton seconded.

Bill made a motion that Liberty Township remain as a member of the Northern Tier Coalition. Alton seconded.

Bill made a motion to reappoint Debra Lindsey as alternate township secretary. Alton seconded.

Bill made a motion to appoint Kyra Roe as Deputy Tax Collector valid until 2017. Alton seconded.
