Pledge of Allegiance was said.

Public Comments Rach Magargal requested assistance from the township for problems they are having with Frontier internet and phone that is not working. Frontier has not been able to solve the issues and Jonathan Fritz office told them to contact the township. Discussion followed.

Minutes Dave made a motion to accept the March 2021 Meeting Minutes as presented. Alton seconded and Doug voted yes.

Road Report Dave reported the following March 2021 activities: potholes repaired on Bailey, Valley View, Trip, Lyons, Upper Rhiney, Lower Rhiney, Howard, Stonecrop, Hunsinger, Mucky, English and Mill, cut trees and check roads after each windstorm and rebuild Holy Road.

Treasurer's Report The 2020 DCED Annual Audit and Financial Report is being finished. Janette reported no changes.

Dave made motion to accept March 2021 Treasurer's Report, pay the Bill List 04-2021 and pay any bills which are normally paid during the month and pay the payroll for April. Doug seconded and Alton voted yes.

Doug reported Jim Brozena, flood consultant, plans to meet with the 5 homeowners regarding the PEMA estimates as soon as he has figures from PEMA.

Doug reported an individual wants to establish a brewery business in the township and the records from 1936 & 1937 regarding no retail sales of liquor or beer in the township are no longer available. He stated Michael Giangrieco office suggested to have the liquor board determine if it is an eligible business per their guidelines.

New Business Doug reported the American Rescue Act states the township will be receiving some funds. PSATS recommends waiting for the Federal and State guidelines to be established regarding how the funds can be used.
