May 7, 2026

The monthly meeting was held on Thursday, May 7th, 2026 at the Liberty Township garage at 5050 Creamery Road Montrose PA 18801.

The meeting was called to order by Lori Raub at 7PM. The supervisors discussed the auction of the GMC pickup and International dump truck. They agreed to have Doug from Auctions International make calls to try to make more money on the trucks and process the sales.

An update on the Grange Hall was given by Lori Raub; the floors, mini splits, and internet are being installed; cameras and plumbing will be installed soon. She also stated that an open house will be held at some point for the public.

Darin DeRose gave the road report; they are working hard on with ditching, adding material and will be topping some roads soon. He also wanted to make note that he contacted Jordan DePue for hauling twice and he was unavailable.
